

Master's Degree in Audiovisual and Literary Culture

What does the master's degree consist of?

This master's degree, with a professional and research orientation, addresses, on the one hand, the essential texts and main literary movements of the 20th and 21st centuries, exploring literary forms ranging from the commercial novel to comics, micro-stories, film scripts, chronicles and electronic literature, as well as their different manifestations based on the most recent trends in literary studies. On the other hand, it focuses on audiovisual culture linked to the rise of audiovisual media and the widespread use of information and communication technologies.

What career opportunities are there?

The degree qualifies students to occupy jobs in sectors related to cultural management, both in the field of literary and audiovisual culture, media, and interactive digital spaces, etc.

- Research in the field of languages, literatures and the cultures that contextualise them.
- Editing of texts.
- Advising public administration bodies on matters relating to knowledge of other languages and cultures, particularly in the field of administration, the institutions of the European Union and the Diplomatic Corps.
- Management in the field of cultural tourism.
- Organisation of cultural events and recreational-cultural activities associated with the areas covered by the degree.
- Promotion of creative and/or educational activities within a range of contemporary languages.
- Management and consultancy in the field of documentation, archives and libraries.
- Qualified consultancy for bookstores.

- Script writing.

Who is it aimed at?

Those who have obtained a degree in the different Philologies, or any of the current degree titles in the fields of Arts and Humanities, Audiovisual Communication or Teacher Training.

Who is the teaching staff?

Qualified lecturers (PhD or doctor) status provided by the Departments of Modern Philology, Translation and Interpretation, and Hispanic Philology, Classical Philology and Arabic and Oriental Studies at the ULPGC.

This degree, which is delivered in face-to-face sessions, also has, as a complementary resource for teaching and academic or administrative management, the 'Virtual Campus' online platform, enabled for sending assignments, requesting virtual tutorials, downloading the course syllabuses, or participating in forums, among other functions.
